stars in country music and classic rock from Alabama to ZZ Top and has been named "Country Music Club of the Year" 12 times by the Academy of Country Music and the Country Music Association. Visitors to Billy Bob's are greeted by a history video narrated by George Strait and, in addition to great food, can enjoy a large collection of music and memorabilia, as well

as the Wall of Fame, where your hands match up to those of Garth, Willie, Ringo, and over 250 other performers.
